Waterbury Village Meeting To Vote On Fire Station

WATERBURY — The trustees for the Village of Waterbury have called a special village meeting to be held in the high school banquet hall, Monday evening, April 6 at 8.

The meeting is being called upon petition of the voters to consider the construction of a new fire station. As the result of improper wording of the warning for the annual meeting last month, the question could not be voted upon.

Two other articles also appear in the special warning, one regarding the installation of a new automatic fire alarm system in the fire station which will be necessary when the village telephone system changes over to dial, and one to see if the village will appoint a committee to look into the possibility of establishing a planning commission for the village.
